Your arrival in France:

From July 1st 2021, foreign tourists must present a Health Pass on arrival in France.

What is this pass?

It is a QR code on your phone that allows you to prove :

- either a recent negative PCR test (-24h),
- or a vaccination
- or a certificate of recovery from Covid

We can help to arrange the PCR test for the departure. The cost of the PCR test in France is 85 Euros. The test is done in a laboratory.



The school

Wearing a mask is compulsory in class and in all common areas of the school. Students must bring their own mask.

Social distancing will be respected inside the school as well as in the school gardens.

Hydroalcoholic gel dispensers will be available at the school entrance, in all common areas and in the classrooms.

Students should ensure that they wash their hands when entering and leaving the room. Classrooms are ventilated at break time and at lunchtime.

Our vending machine will be condemned, please bring your own bottle, snacks or thermos.

Classrooms and bathrooms will be disinfected twice a day.

Inside the school, a staff member will be a Covid referent and received the proper training.

The classes and schedule

Depending on classroom size, classes will count between 5 and 10 students.

You will be informed on your App mobile of your schedule 1 day ahead.

We will not provide any pen and paper, nor tablettes or laptop. Please bring your own.

Activity Programme

We will offer a reduced activity programme.

We will offer a large list of activity ideas to do individually or in small groups.



Accommodation

Hotels and residences will have to follow a guideline given by French authorities which differentiate from the regulations we have to put in place in our school. alpha.b is not responsible for the good practice of these guidelines.

For host family accommodation, at this stage there is NO guideline or regulation in place. We have to rely on both, host families' and students' common sense to cohabit in Covid19 times by applying all necessary hygiene measures to protect each other.

alpha.b declines all responsibility relating to Covid19 for host family accommodation.

For precaution reasons, you will understand that we can only offer single room accommodation besides for couples or students travelling together and wishing to share a double room.

Life in Nice



Wearing a mask is compulsory in Nice in all enclosed space (shops, pharmacies, bank etc).

As well as on pedestrian streets

Pass sanitaire (Green Pass)

The «pass sanitaire» is compulsory for leisure and cultural venues with more than 50 people (theatres, amusement parks, concert halls, festivals, sports venues, cinemas, etc.). It is also compulsory in cafés, restaurants, certain shopping centres, hospitals, old people's homes, medical and social establishments, as well as for travel by plane, train and bus for long-distance journeys.

What is the «Pass sanitaire»?

The «pass sanitaire» consists of the presentation, digitally (via the TousAntiCovid application) or on paper, of one of the following three health proofs

1. Full vaccination (Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Johnson & Johnson)
2. Proof of a negative RT-PCR or antigenic test less than 24 hours old
3. Positive RT-PCR test result showing recovery of Covid-19, at least 11 days old and less than 6 months old.

The «pass sanitaire» is compulsory from the age of 12.

Protocol in case of suspicion of Covid19

Reminder: In the current context, anyone with fever and / or cough / difficulty breathing / speaking or swallowing / loss of taste and smell is likely to be affected by Covid-19

The different stages :

- In case of mild symptoms, the Covid referent will make an appointment with the attending doctor of the school. If the student is a minor, the parents will be immediately informed and a member of the school will accompany the student to the medical appointment. Subsequently the minor student will be accompanied to his accommodation in Nice.

- In the event of a sign of distress, the Covid referent will call the SAMU and the latter will decide to send help. If the student is a minor, the parents will be immediately informed and a member of the school staff will accompany the student.

- After taking charge of the student, the Covid referent will notify the health service and the director. If the Covid case is confirmed, the contact identification and quarantine measures will be implemented. The student will be asked to stay in their homestay or other accommodation for a minimum of 14 days, and we will be following health authorities recommendations.

NB : In the event of a quarantine imposed by French health authorities, all additional costs (accommodation, airplane tickets, treatments ...) will be at your expense.

Obligation

Each student must respect the health rules and the organization set up by alpha.b Institut Linguistique.
